

Brass Sponge Iron Tip Cleaner

To clean iron tips, you may use sandpaper, a [wet sponge](#). A brass sponge, also known as dry copper sponges or brass wool cleaner, works better than these conventional ways. This brass sponge is preferred by many soldering pros for cleaning off the [tips of the soldering irons](#). It is very convenient to use, simply plunge the iron tip into the coils. It never needs wetting, won't cool down the tip, and its slightly abrasive to remove caked-on flux.



ATTEN iron tip brass sponge is designed in a ball-style which has a good-looking. Also, this ball style sponge holder is lower profile, so it fits easily into your soldering kit.

The brass sponge tip cleaner is made from coils of brass, which are softer than the tip plating yet hard enough to lessen oxidation to clean the tip. This cleans better than a wet sponge and won't reduce the tip temperature. No more dealing with smelling burnt sponges when cleaning tips. Although a brass wire tip cleaner has many advantages in the [iron tip care](#), there are some downsides as well. For example, you have to be careful if you move it around or else you might get tiny balls of solder everywhere.
